

LONNY L. KOLLN II APPOINTMENT TO SECTION COUNCIL

President Guy Cook of the Iowa State Bar Association has notified Lonny L. Kolln II of his reappointment to the Elder Law Section Council for the 2013-14 term. Section council members normally serve an initial 3 year term and may be reappointed by bar leadership to a second three year term. The section council member must then go off the section council for one

year before being reappointed.

The Elder Law Council is composed of members who have an interest in issues specific to the elderly population. The Council discusses ideas, ask and answer questions and access resources that further knowledge in this area of the law. The group also organizes continuing education seminars to educate and alert others to any new and revised federal and state law impacting older citizens in Iowa.
