PECHACEK NAMED LIFETIME HONORARY DIRECTOR

The University of Iowa Law School Foundation has named Frank W. Pechacek, Jr. as a Lifetime Honorary Director. Mr. Pechacek has served on the Foundation since 2006. He is also on the Board of Directors, Treasurer and Chair of the Finance Committee. While Chair of the Finance Committee, the Iowa Law School Foundation brought in a \$50 million capital campaign, over goal and on time.

In 1993, Mr. Pechacek co-founded the law firm of Willson & Pechacek, P.L.C., in Council Bluffs. Mr. Pechacek is admitted to practice law in both Iowa and Nebraska. His practice is concentrated in the fields of business

law, tax, estate planning, trusts, probate and real estate.

He has served as chair of the Business Law Section Council of the Iowa State Bar Association and editor-in-chief of the 2005 Business Law Manual, and he is a former commissioner of the Iowa Supreme Court Nominating Committee. He currently serves as director and past President of Southwest Iowa Educational Foundation, Inc., Pottawattamie County Community Foundation Investment Committee, Vice President of Charles E. Lakin Human Services Campus Foundation and serves as Commissioner on the Pottawattamie County Civil Service Commission. He is an Honorary Lifetime Director and past Board Chair of the Loess Hills Chapter of the American Red Cross. In 2010, Mr. Pechacek was awarded the Heritage Award by the Alegent Health Foundation. In 2011, he was awarded the Leadership and Exceptional Volunteer Awards from the American Red Cross.
